

MS Logistics to Expand National Cold Chain Capacity by Nearly 70% to More Than 72,000 Pallet Positions

A new Jeddah facility will extend the company's temperature-controlled network across the Kingdom's two principal distribution markets

RIYADH, 18 August 2026 — **MS Logistics**, a specialized third-party logistics provider delivering end-to-end temperature-controlled supply chain solutions across Saudi Arabia, today announced the next phase of its national expansion: a new cold and frozen storage facility in Jeddah that will take the company's combined capacity to more than 72,000 pallet positions, from 42,500 in operation today.

The expansion establishes a second major operating base for the company, extending its network across Riyadh and Jeddah — the Kingdom's two principal distribution markets and the entry points for the majority of imported temperature-sensitive food products. On completion, MS Logistics will operate more than 54 loading and unloading docks across four staging areas, with multi-temperature chambers spanning -24°C to $+25^{\circ}\text{C}$ to serve frozen, chilled and ambient product profiles under a single operating model.

The announcement comes as MS Logistics prepares to exhibit as a Golden Sponsor of the Saudi Warehousing & Logistics Expo 2026, held from 8 to 10 September 2026 at the Riyadh International Convention & Exhibition Center under the patronage of the Ministry of Transport and Logistic Services. The company will present its integrated cold chain platform at Stand 4A30, Hall 4.

MS Logistics' flagship Riyadh facility, commissioned in March 2025, operates 42,500 pallet positions in the heart of the capital. Operations across the network are governed by HACCP-based quality systems and FEFO inventory management, with daily cycle counts supporting stock accuracy of up to 100 percent. All processes are fully integrated with a Warehouse Management System that gives clients real-time visibility across every pallet and every movement.

Since commencing operations in 2021, the company has built its position around a single specialization: the food cold chain. That focus addresses one of the most persistent challenges facing food manufacturers, retailers and FMCG brands in the Kingdom — maintaining product integrity and audit-ready traceability while distribution volumes grow. The expansion also supports national food security objectives and the ambition, set out under Saudi Vision 2030 and the National Transport and Logistics Strategy, of establishing the Kingdom as a global logistics hub.

"Cold chain is not a storage business — it is a discipline business. Every degree, every date code and every dock movement is either controlled, or it is a risk we have transferred to our client's brand. This expansion is not simply about adding space; it is about extending a proven operating discipline to a second major market, so that a customer distributing in Jeddah receives exactly the standard they receive in Riyadh."

Beyond storage, MS Logistics provides cross-docking in pre-distribution, post-distribution and continuous formats; transportation coordination; compliance management; and a value-added services portfolio spanning promotional bundling, palletizing and shrink-wrapping, labeling and printing, and customized protective packaging for temperature-sensitive food products. The company also offers consultancy on food storage practice and cold chain design for clients developing their own logistics capability.

At the Expo, the MS Logistics team will meet food manufacturers, retailers, FMCG brands and international companies planning market entry or expansion in Saudi Arabia, offering capacity assessments, storage and distribution modeling, and tailored service proposals.

Key Messages

- MS Logistics operates as a dedicated food cold chain specialist rather than a general logistics provider, with multi-temperature capability covering frozen, chilled and ambient profiles under one operating model.
- Operations are governed by HACCP-based quality systems, FEFO inventory management and daily cycle counts, delivering stock accuracy of up to 100 percent with full WMS-enabled visibility.
- The expanded network will allow national brands to consolidate frozen, chilled and ambient inventory with a single accountable partner across both major markets, rather than managing separate providers in each.
